



## From the Pastor,

There is a word being used these days from Bishop Maas to Prepare/Enrich premarital material to Thrivent. The word is gratitude. The Rev. Robert Schuler from the Glass Cathedral preached and wrote about having an “attitude of gratitude” way before it has now become a proper term.

When we are grateful or thankful our whole attitude about God, others, and ourselves changes. We become more generous with God without time and money. When we focus our reasons to be thankful for our spouse in our lives and not focus on their faults our short comings, we can be more forgiving towards them and overlook the tiny irritations we may feel towards them at times. When we realize that God has been generous with us through the Son, we can live generously with and towards others.

November 25 the country celebrated a Day of Thanksgiving. Between Thanksgiving and Christmas charities try to contact people because at this time of year people appear to be more generous with giving to others through charities. Being grateful at Thanksgiving and anticipating being generous to family at Christmas leads to the willingness to help others.

The Church Season of Advent is a preparatory time in the church to prepare the building for the celebration of Christmas and for the members to prepare their hearts to receive the generous gift from God of the Son from heaven to earth as a child of a human being. God made human. The Son leaving His place and power in heaven to be human for the sake of humans. On Christmas the Son is born and seven days later his name Jesus becomes official.

Jesus is the Son of God. On Christmas day we receive God’s generous gift to us. On Good Friday, Jesus gives us the generous gift of His Life and thus the forgiveness of sins.

Let us spend the Church Year of 2021-2022 looking for God’s generosity in our lives and then discover ways to be generous to God through God’s Church and by being generous to others.




Our sympathy to Shari Siepelmeier and her family as her mother, Charlene (Hesterman) Schafer of Morongo Valley, California, passed away November 15.

## Historic Board

Presiding Bishop of the ELCA Bishop Eaton has been elected as vice-president of the National Council of Churches. The 2021 board of the NCC has made history through the election of women to all five positions. Three are women of color.

## Nebraska Synod Bishop Election

Bishop Brian Maas announced November 22, that he would not fulfill his entire six year term as bishop. His term will end August 31, 2022. At that time he will accept a call as Vice President for Mission and Spiritual Care at Immanuel. He chose this date so the Nebraska Synod has time to hold election of bishop during the 2022 Nebraska Annual Synod Assembly. This will allow the new bishop elect to transition into office with no need for interim bishop.

## THE Tanzania Scholarship PROJECT

Grace Lutheran again this year is sponsoring—**The Tanzania Scholarship Project**. This project sponsors orphans so they can attend a Christian high school. Primary schools in Tanzania are free but secondary schools have fees. Our scholarship students attend one of eleven Lutheran High Schools in northern Tanzania, East Africa. The scholarship for one year of tuition, boarding, uniforms, and school supplies is \$450. In the past fourteen years of this project we have witnessed God working through his people. ***We have made a difference!***

There are many orphans in Tanzania who have no parents due to motor accidents, malaria, or other illness. This is leaving many orphans who go to live with extended families. These families do not have the money to pay the orphan's secondary school fees. Without a scholarship, some of these orphans will have to leave school at a young age and fend for themselves. These students are very thankful for the opportunity that the project provides.

In the past 3-4 years Grace has received donations to sponsor 3 orphans. Your contribution is tax deductible. 100% of your donation goes to your orphan's education! *Donations towards this project should be designated on your offering envelope and then one check will be sent to Sheridan Lutheran in Lincoln. These donations must be in NO LATER than December 28<sup>th</sup>.*

We will receive the name of our orphan, a picture, and a letter from our orphan. Sheridan Lutheran has members who travel to Tanzania and visit the schools. We are encouraged to write letters to the orphan(s) that we are sponsoring. They collect letters from sponsors in January and September and deliver those letters directly to the schools via Sheridan Lutheran missionaries.

**Church Seasons:** There are two church seasons in December. The first is Advent. The first four Sundays in December are part of Advent. It is a time to prepare the building for the Christmas Season as well as prepare our hearts to receive the Christ Child on Christmas morn. The Nativity of Our Lord is December 25 and the beginning of the Christmas Season which runs through January 5th. The twelve days of Christmas is the official time to celebrate the birth of Jesus, the Son of God.
