From the Pastor,

There is a word being used these days from Bishop Maas to prepare/enrich premarital material to Thrivent. The word is gratitude. The Rev. Robert Schuller from the Crystal Cathedral preached and wrote about having an “attitude of gratitude” way before it has now become a popular term.

When we are grateful or thankful our whole attitude about God, others, and ourselves changes. We become more generous with God with our time and money. When we focus on reasons to be thankful for our spouse in our lives and not focus on their faults or shortcomings. We can be more forgiving towards them and overlook the tiny irritations we may feel towards them at times. When we realize that God has been generous with us through the Son, we can live generously with and towards others.

November 25th the country celebrated a Day of Thanksgiving. Between Thanksgiving and Christmas charities try to contact people because at this time of year people appear to be more generous with giving to others through charities. Being grateful at Thanksgiving and anticipating being generous to family at Christmas leads to the willingness to help others.

The Church Season of Advent is a preparatory time in the Church to prepare the building for the celebration of Christmas and for the members to prepare their hearts to receive the generous gift from God of the Son from heaven to earth as a child of a human being. God made human. The Son leaves His place and power in heaven to be human for the sake of humans. On Christmas the Son is born and seven days later his name Jesus becomes official.

Jesus is the Son of God. On Christmas we receive God’s generous gift to us. On Good Friday Jesus gives us the generous gift of His Life and thus the forgiveness of sins.

Let us spend this Church Year of 2021-2022 looking for God’s generosity shown in our lives and then discover ways to be generous to God through God’s Church and by being generous to others.

At that time he will be accepting a call as Vice President to Immanuel Communities. He chose this date so the Nebraska Synod has time to hold election of bishop during the 2022 Annual Assembly and so there would be no need for an interim bishop.
