From the Pastor,

Pentecost was May 19th. It celebrates the gifting of the Holy Spirit to the Church. Acts 2 speaks of a violent wind and tongues of fire.

I think this Acts story was necessary because the disciples were not moved enough when Jesus just breathed upon them the Holy Spirit and gave them the directive to forgive, (John 20:19-23). In John 21 Peter is bored and goes back to his previous way of life and says, "I'm going fishing." Jesus cooks the disciples breakfast and reminds them to feed God's sheep with God's word.

Sometimes we just get bored, tired or just ignore living out our faith for God. Life just becomes so smooth we just coast along without really thinking about God.

That is how I feel about the wind in Nebraska. Some people will complain about how windy it is, only about ten miles an hour. I don't think I ever notice it unless it is 20 miles an hour. I just understand that the wind blows across SE Nebraska and that is how it is.

I believe that is why it took a violent wind to blow into the room for the apostles to notice it. It took tongues of fire floating in the room to get the apostles' attention. Fireflies floating outside always get my attention. This was fire of the Holy Spirit landing on them and not burning them. Sometimes God has to get a little wild in our lives just to get our attention. Sometimes a person has to raise their voice at someone in order to get their attention. When we begin to ignore God in our lives, beware how God might have to move in your life just to get you to notice God in your life.
