On my farewell tour I played one of my greatest hits on Christ the King Sunday. Every few years I bring out Simba from the movies and series, "The Lion King." He sings his song, "I Can't Wait to be King." I compare the difference between how he becomes king and how Jesus becomes king. I then close with Simba singing "Hakuna Matata", (No Worries) and state with Jesus we have no worries.

We end the church year with the reminder that Jesus the Christ is our king ruling with God the Father. Advent begins the church year with me playing another of my hits by loudly celebrating the New Year and explaining that it is the church's new year. But it is also joyful to celebrate the birth of Christ with my church family and I get to do it twice on Christmas Eve. We celebrate Christ's birth and His presence in the bread and wine. It has been a pleasure to be in the Advent struggle and Christmas celebration with Grace and Hope. Merry Christmas!
